

Service Dog Tutor's In-home Companion Dog Training Classes

Positive Obedience Training

(4) 1 hour private classes where you learn effective communication with your dog and positive training techniques while your dog works on these skills: sit, stay, down, loose leash walking, greeting strangers, no jumping, reliable recall. (\$600)

Dog Training While You Work

Are you too busy to train your dog during the week? I will train your dog in a concentrated five week course of one hour sessions once a week and then show you how to work with your dog to maintain his new skills.(\$750)

Around Town With Puppy

This day training program emphasizing socialization and good manners is designed for puppies 3 to 6 months of age. (4) 1 hour private classes where obedience challenges for your dog are paired with an exercise regimen for you (hiking, walking, aerobic and strength exercises). Recall, stay and focus skills are emphasized.(\$600)

My Dog Is My Butler

(4) 1 hour classes to teach your dog useful tasks tasks such as retrieving the leash and your shoes, opening cabinets and finding your keys. (\$600)

Healthy Play And Games With Your Dog
